APPLYING TO APPEAR IN LOCAL SCREENING BOARD INTERVIEW JUN 2025**

**Age (Teaching Staff I – XII)**

1. **Age and Experience Criteria of Candidates.** As on 01 April of the year of appointment, the age and experience of the candidates and weightage to Army Spouses should be as under: -

(a) **Army Spouses (Experience).**

(b) **Army Spouses (Weightage).**

**Note.** For Ser 1 (a) (ii) experience should be in the appropriate category (For PGT category the candidate should have worked as PGT/TGT. Experience gained as PRT in the same period shall not be counted for appointment as PGT. For the post of TGT, experience gained as PRT shall however be accepted and as per extant qualifications laid down by regulatory bodies).

(c) **Others (Experience).**

**Note.** For Ser 1 (c) (ii), 05 years' experience is mandatory in the appropriate category in the last ten years (For PGT category the candidate should have worked as PGT/TGT. Experience gained as PRT in the same period shall not be counted for appointment as PGT. For the post of TGT, experience gained as PRT shall however be accepted and as per extant qualification laid down by regulatory bodies).

## Qualification

2 Minimum qualifications for teaching staff at various levels, i.e., PGT, TGT and PRT will be in accordance with the guidelines issued by NCTE / CBSE /KV Sangathan. Though these minimum qualifications have been considered, in some instances AWES has raised the minimum standards further for the benefit of the students.

4. **Qualification Criteria.** The requisite qualifications are as under:-

B Ed qualified candidates will have to subsequently undergo a six-month PDPET/Bridge Course from an NCTE recognized institution as and when NCTE approves any institution to conduct the said course within two years of recruitment as PRT or beginning of the course whichever is later.	50

### **Note 1.**

(i) \*A Post-Graduate with less than 50% aggregate marks in Graduation can also apply for the post of a TGT / PRT, provided the candidate has scored a minimum of 50% or more aggregate marks in Post-Graduation.

(a) CTET / TET conducted by Centre / State government is **mandatory for appointment as TGTs/PRTs** in the REGULAR and FIXED TERM category. Candidates who have not qualified CTET/TET but found fit in all other aspects may be considered for appointment on vacancies which may be ADHOC in nature.

(b) Aggregate percentage will be based on the marks for the entire duration of Graduation/Post Graduation.

**Appendix****DETAILED LIST OF MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS FOR CANDIDATES**1. **Details of Minimum Qualification.**(a) **PRT (All Subject).**

(i) Graduate holding Bachelor's degree with at least 50% marks in the concerned subject/combination of subjects and in aggregate.

(ii) B.El.Ed./ 02-year D.El.Ed.

OR

In case suitable candidates with D.El.Ed / B.El.Ed qualifications are not available, candidates with B.Ed. or Integrated B.Ed. can also apply with fulfillment of the condition of six-month PDPET/Bridge Course from an NCTE recognized institute as when NCTE approves any institute to conduct the said course within two years of recruitment as PRT or commencement of the course whichever is later.

(iii) Pass in Central Teacher Eligibility Test (CTET)/Teachers Eligibility Test (TET), conducted by CBSE/State Govt in accordance with the guidelines framed by the NCTE for the purpose.

(iv) Proficiency in teaching in English medium.

(v) Knowledge of Computer Application is desirable.

(b) **PRT (Music).** Graduate in/with Music from a recognized university or Graduate with Diploma in Music from Recognised University. Minimum 50% marks in the professional degree/diploma.

(c) **Non-Teaching Academic Staff (Age Criteria same as per Teaching Staff).**

(i) **Counsellor (Health Wellness Teacher).** Graduate with Psychology with a Certificate or Diploma in Counselling with minimum experience of three years as Wellness Teacher/Counsellor.

(ii) **IT Supervisor.** Advance Diploma or Diploma in Computing & Hardware with knowledge in at least two of the following (Hands on experience will be given due weightage):-

(aa) Networking and LAN Administration.

(ab) Operating Systems.

(ac) RDBMS with programming. Proficiency in one language.

(iii) **Science Lab Attendant (Artificial Intelligence Lab).** 10+2 with physics & computer literate.

(iv) **Computer Lab Attendant.** 10+2 with Diploma/Certificate in Computer.

(d) **Pre Primary Staff.**

(i) **Age.**

(aa) **Pre Primary Wing Teachers.** As on 01 Apr 2025, the age of the candidate should not be less than 25 years and more than 40 years if not holding any experience. Candidates with at least five years teaching experience in the last ten years in Pre-primary classes can be enrolled upto the age of 55 years.

(ab) **Ayah.** Maximum age for initial employment 45 years as on 01 Apr 2025, for ex-servicemen – below 55 years.

(ii) **Academic & Other QR.**

(aa) **Pre Primary Teachers.** Passed Senior Secondary (CI XII) with min 50% marks from a recog board. Diploma in Nursery Teacher Edn/Pre School Education/Early Childhood Education Pgme (D.E.C. Ed) of min two years duration or B Ed (Nursery) from NCTE recognized institution.

(ad) **Ayah for Pre Primary Wing.** At least 8<sup>th</sup> pass.
