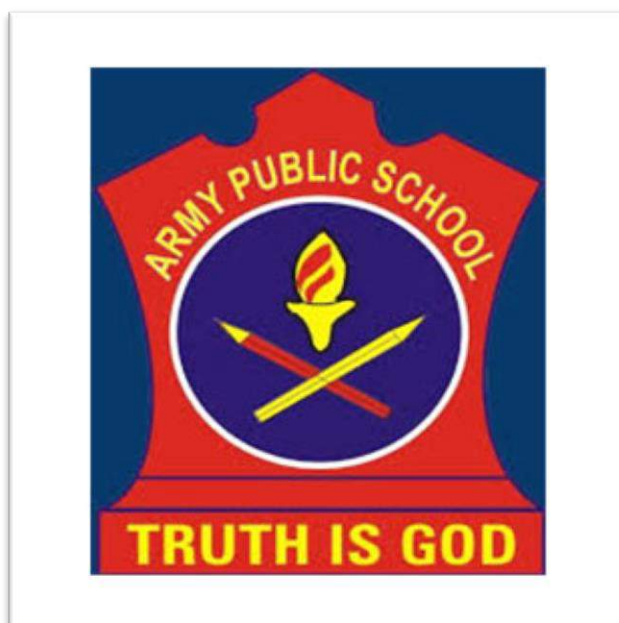

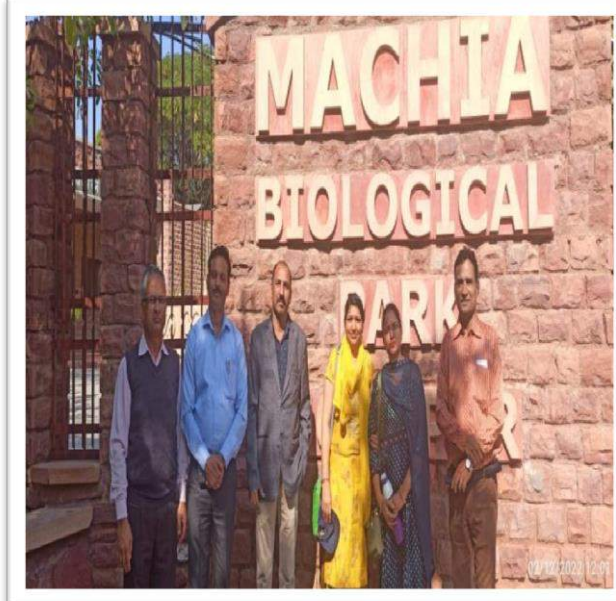
EDUCATIONAL TOUR

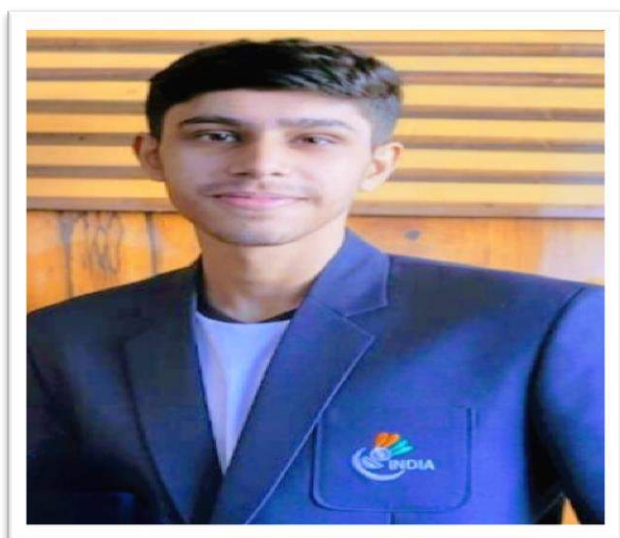
ACHIEVEMENTS

REPORT ON INCLUSIVE EDUCATION

GLAD (Grade Level Assessment Device) is a useful assessment tool for children with learning problems in schools.

Special Educators of our school conducted GLAD assessment for students with learning difficulties. After assessment, teachers interacted with their parents. In Accordance with the result of assessment counseling session was arranged. Remedial measures includes: a. Discussions with class teachers and subject teachers b. Remedial classes c. Revision tests d. Practice sheets, videos to develop their fine motor and gross motor skills. Individual attention is provided to students. Parents were happy to see the improvement.

INTRODUCTION TO THE SCIENCE LABS

On 23 Dec 2022 students of class IV visited the Chemistry, Physics and Biology laboratories in our school. The objective of this visit was to provide an introduction of laboratories to our little ones.
