WEBINAR-34 (27 FEB. -3 MAR.23)

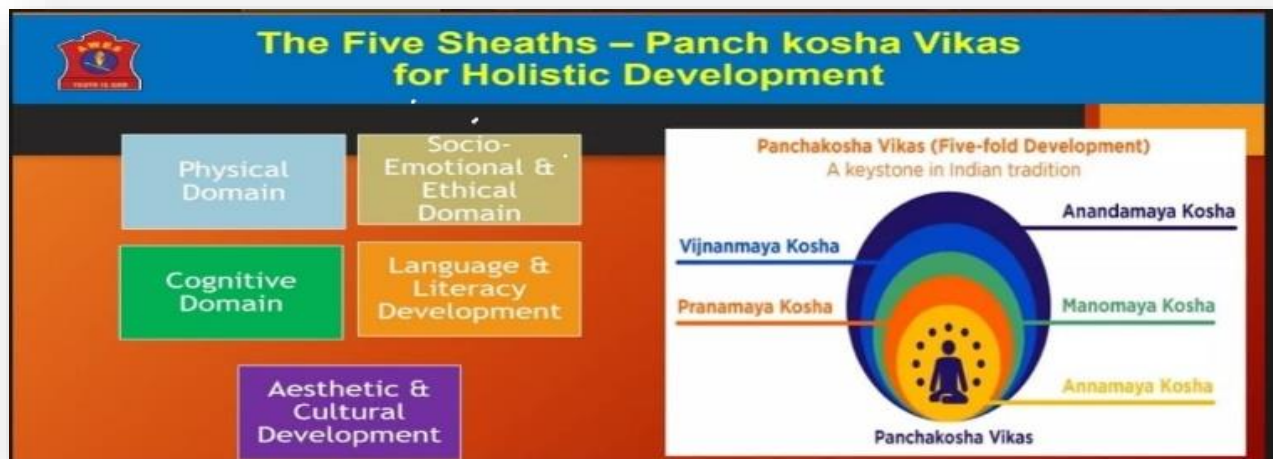
