The chief guest of the session, Mrs. Vandana Pritam, representing FWO, Bogra Brigade, and Mrs. Poonam Bharadwaj, Astha Cell Counsellor at HQ 12 Corps, graced the occasion with their presence. Their involvement reflected the significance of the topic and their commitment to student well-being. We were also honored to welcome Col.
