INTERVIEWS CONDUCTED FOR THE SESSION 2025-26

To ensure the recruitment of qualified and competent faculty for the upcoming academic session 2025–26, the interviews were conducted at Army Public School Jodhpur during the month of March 2025. The interviews were conducted in a transparent and systematic manner. These interviews were held for both teaching and non-teaching staff and were presided over by esteemed officers as detailed below:

1. Local Selection Board (LSB) Interviews

The LSB interviews for academic appointments were conducted over a span of three days from 17th to 19th March 2025. The board was chaired by Col. Jaspreet Singh, Commanding Officer, 6349(1) Mech Wksp. Candidates for various teaching posts were assessed on subject knowledge, teaching methodology, communication skills, and overall suitability for the institution.

2. Head Clerk Interview

The interview for the position of Head Clerk was held on 7th March 2025 under the supervision of Col. Anuj Sharma Comdt, 86 Armd Regt. The candidates were evaluated on their administrative experience, knowledge of office procedures, and organizational capabilities.

3. Local Selection Board (LSB) Interviews

A second round of LSB interviews was conducted from 21st to 22nd March 2025. This panel was presided over by Col. Sarang Pradip Wankhade 50 Lt AD Regt Comp. The focus remained on selecting qualified and efficient teaching staff, with a rigorous selection process ensuring the selection of the most capable candidates.

4. Administrative Officer Interview

The interview for the post of Administrative Officer was conducted on 25th March 2025. The presiding officer for the said interview was Brig. OS Harshwardhan Singh, HQ 12 Corps. The candidates were thoroughly assessed on administrative acumen, leadership qualities, and experience in managing institutional affairs.



CONDUCTION OF BOARD EXAMINATION FOR GRADE X AND XII

Board Examinations for Grades X and XII for the academic session 2024–25 are being conducted smoothly under the guidelines issued by the CBSE and the competent authorities. Adequate arrangements have been made to ensure a fair, secure, and stress-free environment for all examinees.

Grade X: Board Examinations for Grade X commenced on 15th February 2025 and were concluded on 18th March 2025. Students appeared for their respective subjects as per the date sheet provided by the CBSE.

Grade XII: Board Examinations for Grade XII also began on 15th February 2025 and are scheduled to conclude on 4th April 2025.

The school made all necessary arrangements to facilitate the smooth conduct of these examinations, including invigilation, seating plans, and adherence to all statutory examination norms. Throughout the examination period, proper coordination was maintained with CBSE-appointed observers, external invigilators, and school staff to ensure transparency and integrity in the examination process. Students were briefed regularly about examination protocols, and all safety and security measures were strictly implemented. The overall conduction of the board exams has been smooth and efficient.

CONDUCTION OF SCHOOL EXAMINATIONS FOR GRADES VI TO IX AND XI

The final examinations for Grades VI to IX and XI were conducted successfully from February 19, 2025 to March 12, 2025. The exams were held in accordance with the date sheet shared in advance with students and parents. All necessary arrangements were made to ensure the smooth and fair conduct of the examinations. Invigilation duties were carried out diligently, and proper discipline was maintained throughout the exam period.
