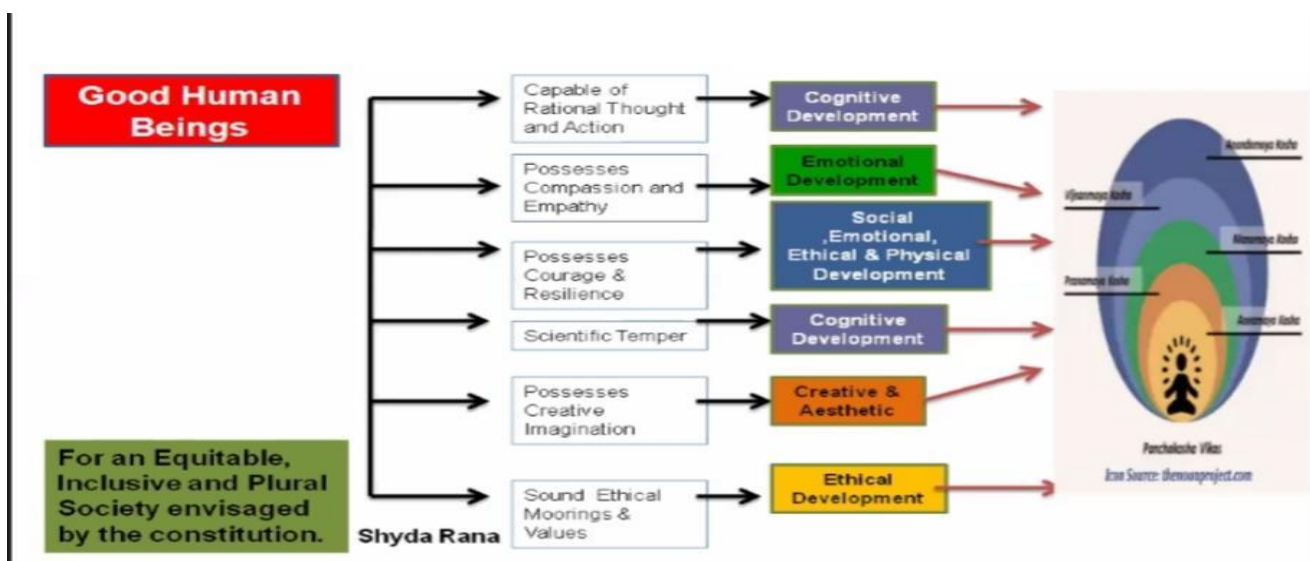
FDRC 5 Days Training

Topic – NCF 2022

An exclusive webinar session was organised by FDRC on the topic ‘**NCF 2022**’ scheduled from 20th February to 24th February 2023. I was very lucky to get a chance to attend the webinar. The session was presided over by MD AWES Maj. Gen G.K. Raina sir, who first gave a vivid outlook on the implementation and importance of NEP. Following that Mrs. Shyda Rana (Senior Faculty Member FDRC) threw light on initiative taken by AWES to implement NEP 2020.

NEP 2022 states that the purpose of the education system is to develop good human being who are capable of rational thought and action, possessing compassion empathy, courage and resilience, scientific temper and creative imagination with sound ethical moorings and values. It aims at producing engaged, productive and contributing citizens for building and equitable by our constitution.

The NCF 2022 is one of the key components of NEP 2020, that enables and energizes this transformation, informed by the aims, principles, and approach of NEP 2020. Out of the proposed four NCFs, the National Curriculum Framework for Foundational Stage was launched in October 2022.



The main agenda of the workshop was implementation of ‘**Balvatika**’ and ‘**Vidhyapravesh**’ programs at the foundational stage of learning through play and activities.

Activity based learning promotes exploration, experimentation, expression in the learners. So we should focus on strategies of ABL, i.e Dramatization, group discussions, role play, educational games, brainstorming, problem solving.

It was indeed a great opportunity to be a part of this webinar, I learnt a lot about NCF 2022, and look forward to implement all what I learned in my teaching.
